Public Transit Legislative Day at the Capitol

March 12, 2025

- The Public Transit Legislative Day at the Capitol brings together leaders from local public transit agencies and other partners to advocate for state policies and funding that support increased transit services and access. The program features refresher training on legislative advocacy, a legislative breakfast, updates from key policymakers, and time for individual or group meetings with legislators.
- Attendees typically include 50+ directors and managers from Michigan transit providers, as well as local transit board members.
 This year, we plan to partner with other allied groups representing riders, labor, environmental, seniors, and disability advocates.
- Sponsorship opportunities include program and breakfast sponsorships.
- Registration: \$125 for individuals, \$100 early discounted rate

Rural Transit Managers Workshop (RTMW)

April 15-16, 2025

- The Rural Transit Managers Workshop (RTMW) is a two-day program providing essential training tailored to rural transit managers and specialized service providers. The workshop includes refresher training on essential topics, timely updates of concern, roundtable discussions, and many opportunities for engaging with Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) staff.
- Attendees typically include nearly 100 directors and managers from 50+ Michigan transit providers, as well as 20+ MDOT staff.
- The agenda allows for regular meals, refreshment breaks, and an evening networking reception. The sessions and speakers will be confirmed and announced soon!
- Sponsorship opportunities include conference & session sponsors, meal & break sponsors, & more.
- This workshop is eligible for reimbursement through the Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) agency funds, and registration is on an individual basis.

Transit Vehicle Maintenance Seminar (TVMS)

June 24-26, 2025

- The Transit Vehicle Maintenance Seminar (TVMS) is a unique three-day program featuring intensive, hands-on training in important maintenance topics. Multiple concurrent sessions are developed with input from maintenance directors and allow attendees to maximize training relevance.
- This program has long been held at the beautiful Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center on the shores of Higgins Lake, providing exceptional opportunities for attendee interaction.
- Attendees typically include more than 75
 maintenance technicians and supervisors
 from 25+ Michigan transit providers, more than
 15 equipment trainers, and 10+ MDOT staff.
- The agenda allows for regular meals, refreshment breaks, and an evening networking reception. There is also a vendor show for transit vehicles and equipment, and opportunities for prize giveaways.



- This workshop is eligible for reimbursement through the Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) agency funds, and registration is on an individual basis.
- Registration: \$240 for individuals, \$215 early discounted rate
- **Vendor opportunities:** \$350 per display includes one 8-foot table *or* space to display one bus; lunch for two people, and recognition on all communications

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Michigan Public Transportation Conference

August 18-20, 2025

- The Michigan Public Transportation Conference is a three-day program that brings together top leaders from Michigan transit agencies, specialized service providers, MDOT, and business partners to discuss key issues.
- The program includes a pre-conference golf outing and networking reception, keynote remarks, numerous general and breakout sessions, and numerous meals and refreshment breaks.
- A large vendor show typically features more than 50 booths, as well as transit vehicles and equipment displays and opportunities for prize giveaways.
- The beautiful northern Michigan host venue, Crystal Mountain Resort, provides a variety of lodging options, many recreation activities, and unparalleled opportunities for on-property attendee interaction.



- Attendees typically include more than 150 transit leaders from 70+ providers, as well as 30+ MDOT and FTA leaders and 70+ vendors.
- Sponsorship opportunities include golf hole and contest sponsors, conference and session sponsors, activity sponsors, and giveaways at the vendor show and at other times.
- This workshop is eligible for reimbursement through the Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) agency funds, and registration is on an individual basis.
- Registration: \$285 for individuals, \$260 early discounted rate
- **Golf outing:** \$100 per person includes 18 holes of golf with cart on the beautiful Mountain Ridge course, breakfast, lunch, on-course beverage, and multiple prize opportunities
